Why should I upgrade to the Shur-Flex™ Crank Arm?

One of the key benefits of the Shur-Flex™ Crank Arm is that it positions the crank out of the way of doors and gates, storing it on the side of the vehicle rather than the back. This flexibility accommodates the use of cargo doors, grain and end dump gates, live-bottom gates and open-top van doors.

The **Shur-Flex**[™] comes in three sizes: 40, 54 and 96 inches. Standard for dump bodies and end dumps is the 54-inch size while the 96-inch size is used for belly dumps, open-top vans and some live-bottom trailers.

In addition to the **Shur-Flex**[™], you'll want to use the offset pinless retainer, which keeps you from having to fumble with the wire lock pins on each side in order to lock the crank in place. The convenience factor here is huge when you consider that there are four pins total (two on each side.) This retainer features a unique retainer lock used with tension springs.
