

Top: The old bow bracket design is pictured on the left. The new bracket's top hole is used on box rails that are 3 inches or less while, for box rails that are over 3 inches in width, the bottom hole is used.

Bottom: The old universal bow bracket is shown at left. The new bracket is the appropriate choice for most lip-in box rails, using the top hole.

Why did Shur-Co[®] re-design the Single Bow Bracket?

Shur-Co[®] changed the design of all **Single Bow Bracket** galvanized steel bow configurations to incorporate our two most commonly used steel bow brackets: Single Bow Bracket P/N 1107009 and Universal Bow Bracket P/N 1115702. The new bracket has two holes on each side to allow for more adjustability.

Examples of this product improvement are pictured at the left, including how the new bow bracket is used on differently configured box rails.
