At Shur-Co[®], LLC we use the finest solid vinylcoated fabric with built-in UV inhibitors to reduce sun damage and fading. Each lot is lab tested for its tear strength, abrasion resistance and cold-temperature flexibility. Our tarps won't shrink, rot or mildew.

Shur-Co[®] quality shows in the details. Reinforced stitching adds strength at stress points, reducing the likelihood of tears. Seams are heat welded for a water-tight bond between panels; the added thickness creates an improved moisture barrier. Durable webbing straps are added to increase wear in areas where the tarp can see abrasion.

Note that our standard tarp design has the straps running up and over the top rail edge on a cart, trailer or tender. These straps are securely stitched to the tarp, which pierces the vinyl-coated material and can allow for minimal water seepage. Stitching also allows some light to penetrate the inside of the box; this is not considered a defect in the tarp.
