

*Valid within the continental 48 states only. Applies to products purchased at standard pricing; any special pricing will void standard prepaid freight policy and will be addressed on a case-by-case basis. Does NOT apply to Bedliners or Shur-Co® Flatbed products.

INTO FL/MI: Freight prepaid on orders of \$2,500 or more or tarp-only orders of \$1,500 or more. INTO ZONES 1 & 2: Freight prepaid on orders of \$3,000 or more or tarp-only orders of \$2,500 or more. INTO ZONES 3 & 4: Freight prepaid on orders of \$6,000 or more or tarp-only orders of \$3,000 or more.



WARRANTY. We warrant all new products are free of defects in materials and workmanship.* This warranty is effective if products are properly installed and used for the purpose for which they were intended and applies to the original buyer only. Except as set forth above or in any product-specific warranty documentation, we make no other warranties, express or implied, including but not limited to warranties of merchantability of fitness for a particular use.

Returns of a product for warranty must be accompanied by a Return Merchandise Authorization number (RMA#), obtained by by calling Customer Service at 800-327-8287, and sent, freight paid by us, to Donovan, 3353 SE Gran Park Way, Stuart, FL 34997. All products returned without an RMA# will be refused. When we issue the RMA#, we will also issue a call tag to have U.P.S. (or other freight company) pick up the product. C.O.D. returns not accepted.

We will pay no storage fees for a warranty product return prior to pick by us or the freight company. If a warranty product return is scheduled to be picked up by us, we will pick up the product at our earliest convenience. If a product returned is found, in our judgement, to be defective in material or workmanship, our obligation under this warranty is limited to the repair or replacement of the product, which will be made by us. Repair or replacement will be at our discretion, with replacements being made using current products performing in the equivalent function. Labor charges, other than those incurred at our factory, including, but not limited to, any labor to install a repaired or replacement product, are not covered under this warranty. All expenses associated with delivering defective products to our factory and delivering repaired or replacement products from our factory to the owner will be paid by us.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

RUST PREVENTION


To prevent rust, paint all exposed metal such as weld seams and/or metal exposed by grinding or cutting, with corrosion-resistant paint.




STEP 1: Tarp roller tube assembly requires a minimum of 83.5" for installation without modifications. For widths under,

need to be shortened.



STEP 2: The tarp roller should be mounted as far forward as possible to prevent damage when loading. Allow enough clearance for tarp to wrap around roller tube assembly. Holes must align from side-to-side.




STEP 3: Mark center of roll bar extrusion ②, slide roll tube assemblies ①, ② and ③ together. Place three tubes between mounting brackets leaving 1/4" space on each end. Slide center tube ② to the midpoint and run the self drilling screw 2" from the end of ①. Slide item ③ towards the center and remove from bracket. Slide tarp (sold separately) pocket over roller tube assembly. Slide ③ back in mounting bracket and attach self drilling screw 2" from end.




NOTE: If using pull bar option, do not slide tarp pocket over roller tube assembly. Pocket will go to rear of dump box (Step 7).


STEP 4: Slide bearings over axle ends, fasten bearings with cap screw ② and lock nuts ③ to mounting plates. Longer cap screw ③ must be on the bottom side of the bearing next to the detent hole. Center roller tube assembly and tighten set screws in each bearing.




STEP 5: Slide sprocket hub up against bearing and tighten set screws. Insert detent cap screw ② and nylon washer ④, spacer washer ④, detent lever, washer ④ and lock nut ③. Hook spring to detent lever and bearing cap screw. Place lock nut ③ on end of long bearing cap screw.




STEP 6: Fasten crank handle to end of axle with cap screw and lock nut.




STEP 7: Center tarp on roller tube assembly, using washers @ and self drilling screws @. Evenly space five fasteners along roller tube assembly and run screw through tarp into roller tube assembly.






NOTE: Pull bar option, run washers **3** and self drilling screws **3** through grommets for locations along roller tube assembly

STEP 8: Place set of storage hooks at rear and front of dump box. Keep hooks 24" - 34" apart wrapping rope when not in use. Rope storage hooks can be bolted or welded (fasteners not supplied). Assemble the S-hooks to the rubber straps. Secure S-hooks to tarp and rubber straps by crimping ends.
